And to every parent and teacher — may this book bring joy to your home as you remember that His Word and His Spirit always arrive right on time.






The morning after the garden.

says Eliyah.







**“This is the Feast of First Fruits of Wheat — the harvest of souls!”**




**A glowing scroll unrolls from Heaven. The Dove invites them to add their names.**


**Each child writes in light, promising to walk in His ways.**



## Parent Study Notes:

What Shavuot Tells Us | Key Facts at a Glance  
Shavuot occurs on the 15th day of the 3rd Hebrew month.  
*Ex. 19:1 | Jub. 15:1-2, 16:13-14*

It is both a harvest-festival (First Fruits) and the day when Yahuah renewed covenant with Israel. (*Jub. 6:21*)

According to ancient texts (like the Book of Jubilees), Isaac (son of Abraham) was born on this Feast. (*Jub. 16:13-14*)

In Mary's story, the angel visited her in the "sixth month" (*Luke 1:26*).

If you count nine months from the sixth month, you arrive in the third month—aligning Messiah's birth with Shavuot.

### Why This Matters

Isaac's birth on Shavuot shows a pattern: Yahuah often brings new beginnings on this Feast.

Messiah (Yahusha) fits that pattern: born in the third month, as the Promise to Abraham's seed fulfilled (*Galatians 3:16*, *Genesis 3:15*) and as the First Fruits of the resurrection (*1 Corinthians 15:20*).

Shavuot isn't just about the Law or the Spirit—it's about covenant, harvest, and new life together.

Using the priestly-courses, calendars, and other clues (1700 years of study) gives additional evidence for the timing and purpose. Elizabeth was 6 months pregnant with John in the sixth Hebrew month.

### Highlight to Use with Kids

"On the day Yahuah gave the Law, He also promised Messiah.  
On the day of Messiah's birth, we see the promise kept."

### Parents can ask:

"What day is our calendar saying Yahusha was born?"

"Why is dying and rising like harvest grain a picture of Messiah's work?"

"Why don't we celebrate His true Birthday?"

## How We Teach It & What to Ask

### Talking Points for the Family

Covenant Day – Explain that Yahuah made a big promise with Israel on Shavuot, and also made a new promise through Messiah for all nations.

Harvest Picture – Connect the sheaf of harvest with Messiah as the First Fruit of a bigger harvest of souls.

Timing Clues – Show how Mary's sixth-month reference (*Luke 1:26*) and older texts pointing to the “third month” build the case for Messiah's birth date being this Feast. Sing *Happy Birthday Yahusha!*

Why It Matters – So the children understand: Messiah wasn't born on a random day, but on Yah's day, showing that His plan is perfect. Keeping Shavuot is celebrating His Birthday. Christmas is not!

### Discussion Questions

Why do you think Yah uses feasts (festivals) to teach us about Himself?

What does it mean that Messiah is the First Fruit?  
How does that help you trust Him?

How will our family celebrate Shavuot differently  
now that we know these clues?

### Fun Activity – “Harvest Promise”


Give each child a small sheaf (wheat, grass or craft version) and let them write one promise Yahuah made on one side and how Messiah keeps that promise on the other side. Then during your Shavuot celebration, read each one aloud and hang the sheaves as decorations.

### Parent Note

This material is meant to equip you—not burden you.  
You aren't required to have every date perfect or every argument spelled out. There is no perfected calendar reconcile. What matters most is helping children see the plan of Yahuah in time and feel the wonder of Messiah's arrival.

Use this as a springboard, not a microscope.  
Let your joy in Him shine, and the truths will stick.




